

DIY 2020 Holiday Ornaments

Commemorate this unforgettable year with a handmade ornament.

Each kit includes:

Ugly Sweater Materials

- 1 sweater template
- Felt in various colors
- Pom poms
- Googly eyes
- 1 pipe cleaner
- Glue dots

Toilet Paper Roll Materials

- 1 empty toilet paper roll
- 2 coffee filters
- 1 marker
- 1 piece of twine

Ugly Sweater Instructions

1. Cut out paper template of sweater
2. Trace template on the piece of felt you've chosen for the sweater
3. Twist pipe cleaner into a hanger shape and staple onto back on felt sweater
 - a. It helps to do this prior to decorating the sweater so you can hide the staples. You can use hot glue or double sided tape to attach the hanger, too – just use whatever you have on hand!
4. Cut shapes out of felt to make your “ugly” design
 - a. I chose to make a reindeer, but you can do random shapes, candy canes, snowflakes, or anything else you can think of!
5. Glue felt shapes and pom poms on sweater.
 - a. Plain school glue will work in a pinch, but I recommend using glue dots (included) or a hot glue gun instead.
6. Let dry overnight.



Toilet Paper Roll Instructions

1. Fold 2 opposite sides of one coffee filter to desired width. Make sure it fits on the toilet paper roll. (Images 1-3)
2. Repeat with second coffee filter, making sure the widths match.
3. Attach one coffee filter to the roll with a spot of glue or piece of tape (Image 4)
4. Wind the filter around the roll and attach the end with more tape or glue. (Image 5)
5. Grab your second folded coffee filter and cut one end into a wavy or angled pattern.
6. Attach the uncut end of the second folded coffee filter to the first filter with glue or tape.
7. Wind the second filter around the roll until you get the desired length.
8. Attach with one more piece of tape or glue. I liked my wavy end hanging off the roll a little bit.
9. Using the marker, write whatever you want on the coffee filter. Some examples:
 - a. 2020 – What a year!
 - b. We survived the toilet paper crisis of 2020
 - c. 2020 – Just roll with it
10. Loop the piece of twine through the roll and tie in a knot – your ornament is ready for hanging!
