

SPIDER SOAP

1. Place all of the sliced soap cubes inside a microwave-safe container.
2. Melt soap in the microwave for 10-20 second increments, stirring well after each microwave session, to ensure that the soap is completely melted.
3. When the soap is completely melted, stir in a few drops of soap color and fragrance oil.
 - Dried out soap colorant? Try adding a few drops of water to revive it!
 - *Note: There is way more colorant and fragrance oil in the cups than you need! Add a little bit at a time to get your desired levels.*
4. Add 1 plastic spider to the soap mold.
5. Pour the melted soap into the mold, and allow to sit undisturbed until completely cool.
 - *Note: The cooling process can take anywhere from 30 minutes to 3 hours depending on temperature and humidity levels.*

MATERIALS

- 1 silicone soap mold*
- 1 pipette
- 1 container of green apple essential oil
- 1 container of soap colorant (green, blue, or purple)
- 3.5 oz. clear glycerin soap base
- 2 plastic spiders (1 extra)
- 1 microwave-safe container (Not included)

Please clean and return soap mold by **NOVEMBER 2 so that we can reuse them to make future library projects!*
